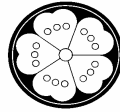


OSU- Washington County Master Gardener Association Scholarship Application

Purpose:

To encourage Washington County students interested in studies related to Horticultural or Plant Science.

Eligibility:

- Applicant must be a resident of Washington County for at least 2 years with a high school, private school or home-school diploma or GED certification.
- Applicant must demonstrate experience and interest in studies related to Horticultural or Plant Science.
- Applicant must be currently enrolled or plan to enroll in an accredited college, university or trade school, in a degree program and taking at least 12 credits per term.
- Applicant must be an enrolled freshman or higher before September 30, 2012.
- Applicant must display a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- This is a one-year scholarship. Former Washington County Master Gardener Association scholarship recipients are eligible to re-apply.

Value Of The Award:

Minimum \$1000 to be used for tuition and/or fees required for enrollment, books, supplies and/or equipment required for course work in the chosen major at an accredited college, university or technical/vocational school. Payment will be made to the institution of choice to be applied as indicated above.

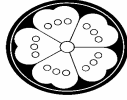
Criteria:

- Students will be chosen on their ability to complete the application as requested and in a timely manner. Included must be the essay, references and the most recent FAFSA. Failure to meet the deadline will result in the no consideration of the application.
- Extra points will be awarded to students who are enrolled in Horticultural, Agronomy, Botany, Agricultural Sciences or Plant Sciences.
- Financial need and merit will be considered
- The Washington County Master Gardener Scholarship Committee reserves the right not to award this scholarship if no suitable applicant is found.
